## Matthew 1:1

<sup>1</sup> The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the Son of David, the Son of Abraham . . .

## Matthew 1:16-17

<sup>16</sup> And Jacob begot Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom was born Jesus **who is called Christ.** <sup>17</sup> So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen generations, from David until the captivity in Babylon are fourteen generations, and from the captivity in Babylon until **the Christ** are fourteen generations.

**[Father] begot [son]  
through [this woman].**

## Matthew 1:5-6

<sup>5</sup> Salmon begot Boaz by Rahab, Boaz begot Obed by Ruth, Obed begot Jesse, <sup>6</sup> and Jesse begot David the King. David the king begot Solomon by her who had been the wife of Uriah.

## Matthew 1:16

<sup>16</sup> And Jacob begot Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom was born Jesus who is called Christ.

## Matthew 1:16

<sup>16</sup> Jacob fathered Joseph, the husband of Mary. From her was fathered Jesus, the One being called Christ.

**Joseph is Mary's husband  
but he's *not* Jesus' father,  
though he gives Jesus legal  
right to the throne of David.**

**Jesus - this One being called  
Christ - was fathered through  
Mary in a different way.**
